Discounts

- Families enrolling more than one child in the Kids Camp, and paying full payments for one or more weeks, are eligible for a 5% discount for any additional siblings. Discounts DO NOT apply to Registration Fees.
- 4 week package offers a discounted rate of Rp 500,000

Securing a Space & Payment

- To secure a space, an application form must be completed and returned to the school office in person or by email with copies of parents & child's passport/KTP &/or visa details.
- Kids Camp payments must be made in advance.
- It is strongly advised that applicants check availability of spaces remaining PRIOR to completing application form and sending money.
- Confirmation of admission will only be given once payment has cleared and the application form has been processed.
- **A booking code will be given as confirmation. Please make a note of this and bring to the school office to sign in and receive camp t-shirt on your child's first day of Kids Camp.**

Refund Policy

- Camp fees are **non-refundable** under any circumstances, unless Kids Camp is cancelled by the school administration.
- Those signed up for the full 4 week camp are eligible for a 50% refund of the balance of weeks if a minimum weeks notice is given. Registration Fee is non-refundable.
- If the school cancels Kids Camp, fees will be fully refunded with the exception of the Registration Fee and prorated Camp days already used.

Uniform Policy

It is required by the Indonesian Department that students wear uniforms. There is a chance that the school can be reprimanded by the government if camp students are found not to be in uniform, so the school Kids Camp policy is that students must wear their Pelangi t-shirt daily. Each child will receive a free t-shirt when registering for Camp. Additional t-shirts are available for purchase in the school office.

Water Policy

If a field trip involves a swimming pool/hot springs/beach, a Swimming Ability & Consent form must be completed.

Food Policy

Pelangi is a PEANUT FREE school. Snack and lunch are provided – please do not bring peanut products to Pelangi as there are children with allergies.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS, CARERS & VISITORS

We believe that Pelangi School staff and children at the Kids Camp are entitled to a caring and safe environment; behaviour that will cause harm, upset or distress to the users of the premises is contrary to the aims and ethos of the school.

The purpose of this agreement is to show the expected code of conduct within Pelangi School so that we can work together and ensure a safe and positive environment for the Kids Camp children, staff, parents, carers and visitors.

Parents, guardians, carers and visitors are expected to show respect and concern for others by:

- supporting the ethos of the Kids Camp & school by setting a good example in their own speech and behavior towards all members of the Kids Camp & school community
- working together with the teachers and staff for the benefit of the children. This includes approaching the school to resolve any issues of concern and to discuss and clarify specific events in order to bring about a positive solution
- adhering to all Kids Camp policies
- driving and parking with consideration and respect for others when dropping off and collecting children from Kids Camp. Cars must be reversed into parking spaces & motorbikes parked in the dedicated area. The one-way system must be observed at all times
- refraining from smoking, consuming alcohol or being inebriated on school property.

In order to support our safe Kids Camp & school environment, Pelangi School does not tolerate:

- disruptive behavior which interferes with the operation of a Kids Camp, office or any other part of the school property
- using offensive language, a raised voice in anger or a display of temper
- approaching someone else's child to chastise them
- threatening behaviour or the use of physical aggression or punishment towards another adult or child
- damaging or destroying school property
- verbal (slandorous) or written (libellous) statements that cause, or are likely to cause, harm to the reputation of Pelangi School, staff or Yayasan/Advisory Board members.

The use of technology or social media websites is an unacceptable platform to resolve any situation that might arise and is not in the best interest of the children or the school community.

Any concerns will be dealt with fairly, appropriately and effectively, but must be made through the proper channels by speaking to the Kids Camp staff, who can inform Advisory Board, if necessary.

Pelangi School therefore, does not tolerate any abusive, threatening, malicious, libelous or defamatory comments within emails, phone or social network messages.

In the event that any Kids Camp parent, guardian or carer does not uphold this Code of Conduct, the Director and the Advisory Board will be notified. The offending adult may be banned from entering school grounds or the offenders child(ren) excluded from Kids Camp to safeguard our school and camp community.
